

Strengthening Life Skills

A Secure Setting

Gateway provides a structured residential program for those who are reentering the community from a component of the criminal justice system and for those who have compliance issues with the court or Department of Corrections parole orders. The facility is staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week with resident care counselors who maintain safety and security for residents and staff as well as ensure the facility meets all standards for neatness and cleanliness.

Meet Diverse Client Needs

In addition to providing housing, meals, and treatment if needed, our staff works with clients to strengthen their life skills so that they are better equipped to succeed in all areas of life. Clients receive training and mentoring in interpersonal communications, health, social skills, finance, and other areas as determined by assessments or as indicated by client.

The professional staff represents a diverse background in counseling and corrections. Our experience in navigating numerous programs and social agencies allows us to help each client meet their specific needs. Gateway staff members treat all clients, regardless of where they may be in the criminal justice system, in a professional, respectful manner and serve the individual client to the best of their ability.



Employment Support

Trained and Ready to Work

Understanding that employment is the foundation of a successful community reentry, Gateway places special emphasis on assisting clients with developing the skills needed to find, secure, and retain employment. Among the other services offered, Gateway residents have access to our Phoenix Day Reporting Center, which is on the first floor of the facility, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. While at Phoenix they may obtain additional staff assistance in the areas of job search, computer skills, and resume writing.

Staff also helps Gateway clients in obtaining various scholarships for furthering their education and enrolling in public assistance when necessary.

Urban Farming Initiative

Gateway is a proud partner with Urban Farming Initiative through Wayne County Community Corrections. This partnership allows clients to take ownership in a garden, from planting through harvest. In addition to being able to share the fruits of their labor with anyone they wish, the Urban Farming Initiative also increases vocational skills and confidence helpful in obtaining and maintaining gainful employment. Urban Farming sites are supervised by Master Farmers from Michigan State University.



Individualized Care

Helping Clients Reach Their Goals

Our Clinical Supervisor works with Case Managers to ensure that each client has a personalized client-centered plan that is focused on the client's specific goals and objectives. Using assessment tools that are proven by research to be effective, we address and meet each client's individual needs.

Keeping Clients Focused on Success

Sometimes the day-to-day challenges of life can impact our behavior, our work, our health and our relationship with others. Our clinical supervisor and staff work with clients to equip them with the skills to respond appropriately to issues as they arise. We help clients develop the skills needed to respond to future challenges in a solution-oriented manner.



Additional Support for those with Substance Use Disorders

Realizing that many individuals in the criminal justice system have a drug and/or alcohol use or abuse history, treatment of substance use disorders is available to anyone who may need it. We are licensed through the State of Michigan and each of our clinicians are trained in research-proven treatment methods. While in our care, clients can participate in cognitive behavioral treatment that addresses issues of use, abuse, and relapse. In addition, clients also benefit from weekly on-site AA and/or NA meetings. These meetings are facilitated by community volunteers to help maintain the anonymity of the 12-step program participants.

Creating Safer Communities

Providing Stepping Stones to Success

Project Rehab's residential reentry programs help clients effectively transition from the criminal justice system to the community. While in our care, clients receive housing and meals in a supportive environment while we help equip them with the life skills and other resources they need to successfully reenter the community.

Michigan Prisoner Reentry Initiative

Project Rehab is proud to be an active participant in the Michigan Prisoner Reentry Initiative (MPRI). The primary goal of MPRI is to promote public safety by increasing the success rates of prisoners transitioning from prison to the community. The vision of the MPRI is that every prisoner released from prison will have the tools needed to succeed in the community.

- MPRI is a statewide strategic approach to create safer neighborhoods and better citizens.
- MPRI delivers a seamless plan of services, support, and supervision from the time a prisoner enters prison through their return to a community.
